FUNDRAISING EFFORTS

Dogs (and dog owners) require exercise and socialization to keep them physically and mentally healthy. With the help of Marshall Community Services (MCS) Recreation Coordinator, Cam Bailey, a volunteer committee of dog owners has been formed to identify the park's needs and to coordinate fundraising efforts. We are seeking individual and business donations to complete this project.



In order to create a proper environment, additional items will need to be purchased; therefore, funds will need to be raised. Our Phase I goal is \$5,000. Picnic tables or benches will be needed. Shaded areas and a water station for

people and pets will provide a welcome relief in the summer months. We will also purchase signage, waste disposal bags and receptacles. The dog park is scheduled to open in spring of 2012.

BENEFITS OF A DOG RUN

Dogs cannot get sufficient exercise without being able to run, and until now, there has been no place in town where dog owners could legally exercise their pets, off-leash, in a contained and safe environment. A search of "dog parks" on the internet demonstrates there is a high demand for these facilities and many people plan vacation travel so that they can stop at these parks along the way.

WHERE WILL IT BE?

As part of the Tiger Lake Retention Pond project, a section of the retention pond area has been designated as Marshall's first fenced, off-leash dog exercise area. This will be a place for Marshall residents to meet with others who share this interest. The designated area at 111 A Street is already fenced in and is located at the highest point in the retention pond area.
